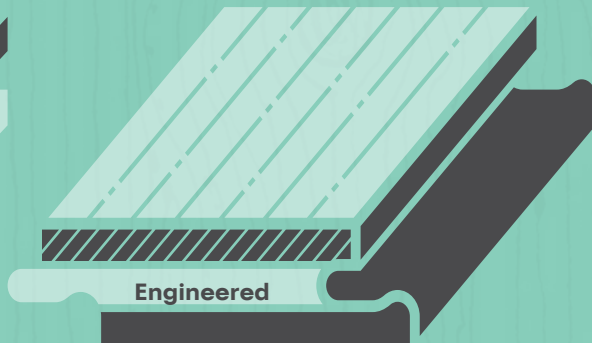


WOOD FLOOR SELECTOR GUIDE

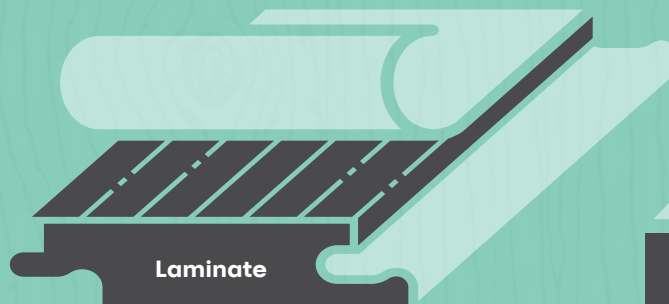
